The Court orders that the delayed application for leave to appeal is GRANTED. The appeal is limited to the issue concerning whether defendant has been deprived of a meaningful opportunity for parole as required by *Graham v Florida*, 560 US 48; 130 S Ct 2011; 176 L Ed 2d 825 (2010). MCR 7.205(E)(4). In all other respects, the delayed application for leave to appeal is DENIED.

“Defendant’s Motion to Supplement His Motion for Leave to Appeal Pursuant to MCR 7.216 *et seq.*” is GRANTED. The exhibit accompanying that motion is accepted for filing.

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED and fees are WAIVED for this case only.

On the Court’s own motion, the case is REMANDED to the Wayne Circuit Court, which shall, within 14 days, appoint appellate counsel for defendant. MCR 7.216(A)(7). Within 14 days after the entry of the order of appointment, counsel shall file in this case a copy of the order of appointment. Within 56 days of the order of appointment, counsel shall file a brief in accordance with MCR 7.212(C) addressing the issue set forth in this order. MCR 7.216(A)(9).
