Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because, whether considered singly or in combination with the other orders referenced by appellant, the order dated January 10, 2017 and entered in the circuit court register of actions on January 11, 2017 is not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). Particularly, the January 11, 2017 order is not a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(iii) because the relevant orders relate to parenting time, not to the custody of a minor. At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the January 11, 2017 order and/or the other circuit court orders he references by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G).

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED for this case only.
