

The court orders that the motion to affirm is GRANTED because it is manifest that the questions sought to be reviewed are so unsubstantial as to need no argument or formal submission. MCR 7.211(C)(3).

The motion for sanctions for vexatious proceedings is also GRANTED based on the lack of reasonable basis for belief that appellant's brief presented a meritorious issue to be determined on appeal. MCR 7.211(C)(8); MCR 7.216(C)(1). We REMAND this case to the trial court to determine and award appellees actual damages and expenses incurred due to this vexatious appeal. MCR 7.216(C)(2).

We do not retain jurisdiction.
