The Court orders that, in lieu of granting the delayed application for leave to appeal, this case is REMANDED to the trial court for further proceedings consistent with this order. MCR 7.205(E)(2). The trial court erred by imposing monetary assessments in the judgment of sentence without having orally informed defendant in open court that such monetary assessments would be imposed as part of his sentence. *People v Bingaman*, 144 Mich App 152, 160-162; 375 NW2d 370 (1984). On remand, the trial court shall conduct a resentencing hearing with defendant physically present and shall orally inform defendant at that resentencing of any monetary assessments to be imposed in the amended judgment of sentence that the trial court shall enter after the resentencing hearing.

The motion to remand is DENIED as moot in light of the peremptory relief afforded as to the delayed application.
