Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.201(B)(3), orders:

The original complaint for superintending control is DISMISSED for failure to pursue the case in conformity with the rules. MCR 7.201(B)(3) and 7.216(A)(10). The Clerk of this Court provided notice regarding the nature of the defects in this filing, and the defects were not corrected in a timely manner by providing this Court with a copy of plaintiff's prisoner account statement for the prior 12 months, five copies of a supporting brief for the original complaint for superintending control, proof of service of the complaint, supporting brief, and attachments to the complaint on the prosecution as the opposing party in the underlying case, and proof of service of the supporting brief on defendant circuit judge. Dismissal is without prejudice to whatever other relief may be available consistent with the Court Rules.

The motions for immediate consideration and to waive fees are also DISMISSED as moot.
