The Court orders that the motion to extend the time to file the transcript is GRANTED ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT the time for Court Reporter Eileen S. Higer (R 5018) to file the transcripts is extended to July 14, 2017.

The transcripts were ordered on February 24, 2017, and were due on May 26, 2017. This Court sent a notice of late filing email to Reporter Higer on June 2, 2017. On June 5, 2017, Reporter Higer filed a defective motion to extend the time, with no filing fee, an improper proof of service and the incorrect circuit court case number. Her stated reason why this Court should extend the time for furnishing the transcript was “[t]ranscript will not be completed.” She asked for an extension to August 11, 2017, an additional 77 days, for a total of 168 days, or almost double the time allotted by court rule. To date, the transcripts already are over 28 days overdue, and this Court has no record that Reporter Higer has filed any of the volumes.

If a copy of the notice of filing the transcript has not been filed with the Clerk’s Office of the Court of Appeals on or before July 14, 2017, the court reporter may be subject to disciplinary action pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f), which could include the assessment of costs, issuance of an order barring the court reporter from recording further proceedings until all of the reporter’s overdue transcripts ordered for purposes of appeal are filed with the trial court clerk, and/or issuance of an order to show cause why the reporter is not in contempt of this Court.
