The Court orders that the application for leave to appeal is GRANTED. The time for taking further steps in this appeal runs from the date of the Clerk's certification of this order. MCR 7.205(E)(3). This appeal is limited to the issues raised in the application and supporting brief. MCR 7.205(E)(4).

Gleicher, J. would deny the application as the court has not relinquished jurisdiction. Affording respondent an opportunity to demonstrate her fitness in Macomb County is entirely consistent with the goal of all termination proceedings. Respondent previously demonstrated her fitness as to children under the jurisdiction of the Wayne County Circuit Court. The child at issue here remains in foster care with supervised visitation, and is in no danger. Until respondent has had an adequate opportunity to abide by (or violate) a parent-agency agreement, the trial court correctly concluded that termination is improper. Accordingly, no grounds exist for this Court to intervene.
