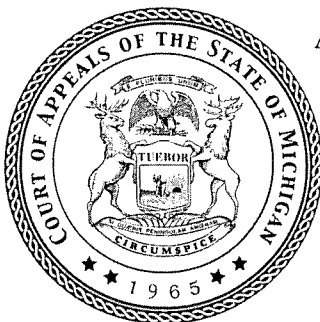

Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.201(B)(3), orders:

The delayed application for leave to appeal is DISMISSED for failure to pursue the case in conformity with the rules. MCR 7.201(B)(3) and 7.216(A)(10). The Clerk of this Court provided notice regarding the nature of the defects in this filing, and the defects were not corrected in a timely manner by providing this Court with a copy of appellant's prisoner account statement for the prior 12 months, five copies of an application for leave to appeal conforming to MCR 7.212(C), five copies of a current set of the circuit court register of actions, and proof of service of the conforming application on all other parties. Dismissal is without prejudice to whatever other relief may be available consistent with the Court Rules.

The motion for appointment of counsel is DENIED because appellant has not shown an entitlement to appointed counsel in this civil case.

The motion to waive fees is DISMISSED as moot.
