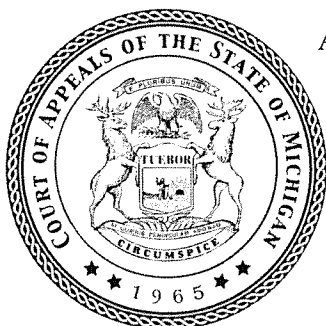

The Court orders that in lieu of granting the delayed application for leave to appeal, this case is REMANDED to the trial court for further proceedings consistent with this order. MCR 7.205(E)(2). On remand, the trial court shall either articulate on the record its basis for imposing court costs on defendant in the judgment of sentence or, if it determines that imposition of that amount of court costs is not supported, enter an amended judgment of sentence with any court costs imposed in the amended judgment of sentence to be supported by an appropriate articulation on the record of the basis for determining the amount imposed. *People v Konopka*, 309 Mich App 345, 360; 869 NW2d 651 (2015). In all other respects the delayed application for leave to appeal is DENIED for lack of merit in the grounds presented.

We do not retain jurisdiction.
