Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.201(B)(3), orders:

The delayed application for leave to appeal is DISMISSED for failure to pursue the case in conformity with the rules. MCR 7.201(B)(3) and 7.216(A)(10). The Clerk of this Court provided notice regarding the nature of the defects in this filing, and the defects were not corrected in a timely manner by providing this Court with a copy of appellant's prisoner account statement for the prior 12 months, five copies of an application for leave to appeal conforming to MCR 7.212(C), five copies of the judgment of sentence appealed from, proof of service of a conforming application for leave to appeal on appellee, five copies of a current set of the circuit court register of actions, copies of the plea and sentencing transcripts, and a copy of the presentence report. Dismissal is without prejudice to whatever other relief may be available consistent with the Court Rules. The Court notes that the delayed application for leave to appeal filed by appointed appellate counsel on defendant's behalf in Docket Number 340526 remains pending in this Court.

The motion to waive fees is also DISMISSED as moot.
