The Court orders that the September 19, 2017 bench ruling of the Family Division of the Ionia Circuit Court denying appellant's petition for waiver of parental consent for an abortion is REVERSED, that the September 19, 2017 order effectuating that ruling is VACATED and that appellant's petition for waiver of parental consent is GRANTED. Upon review of the entire record, the Court is persuaded that appellant met her burden of establishing that she is sufficiently mature and well enough informed to make the decision regarding an abortion independently of her parents. This order shall serve as the order granting waiver of parental consent required by the Parental Rights Restoration Act, MCL 722.901 *et seq.*, and shall remain valid for 90 days from the date of the Clerk's certification of this order. MCR 3.615(K)(1). The Clerk shall provide appellant or appellant's attorney with two certified copies of this order. Nothing in this order shall require or permit an abortion otherwise prohibited by law.

Boonstra, P.J., would affirm the trial court's order denying appellant's petition for waiver of parental consent for an abortion.
