The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The motion to file portions of the application and motion for immediate consideration under seal is GRANTED. This Court finds good cause to seal portions of those documents due to the confidential nature of the contractual provisions at issue, and determines there are no less restrictive means to adequately and effectively protect the interest asserted. MCR 7.211(C)(9)(e).

The Clerk shall disclose or provide copies of any order or opinion entered in this appeal, MCR 8.119(I)(5); MCR 7.211(C)(9)(c), but sealed pleadings or other contents of the file shall not be disclosed or made available for public viewing.

The Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this order to the Clerk of the Supreme Court and to the State Court Administrative Office. MCR 8.119(I)(7); MCR 7.211(C)(9)(c).

The application for leave to appeal is GRANTED. The time for taking further steps in this appeal runs from the date of the Clerk's certification of this order. MCR 7.205(E)(3). This appeal is limited to the issues raised in the application and supporting brief. MCR 7.205(E)(4).

On its own motion, the Court orders that this case shall be EXPEDITED. The appellants' brief is due no later than 21 days from the date of the Clerk's certification of this order. The appellee's brief is due no later than 21 days after service of the appellants' brief. No extensions of time will be allowed for filing of the briefs except by order of the Court.

The Clerk is directed to place this case on the next available case call after the expiration of the time to file appellee's brief.

On its own motion, the Court orders that trial court proceedings are STAYED pending resolution of this appeal or further order of this Court.
