## ORDER

The Court orders that the motion to remand pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(1) is GRANTED.

Defendant shall initiate the proceedings on remand within 14 days of the Clerk's certification of this order. Defendant is to file with this Court a copy of any motion and any supporting brief filed in the trial court within 14 days of the Clerk's certification of this order. Defendant must file with the Clerk of this Court copies of all orders entered on remand within 14 days after entry. The trial court is to hear and decide the matter within 56 days of the Clerk's certification of this order. The trial court is to make findings of fact and a determination on the record. The trial court is to cause a transcript of any hearing on remand to be prepared and filed within 21 days after completion of the proceedings.

Defendant may file a supplemental brief pertaining to the issues raised on remand within 21 days after entry of the trial court's order deciding the matter or 21 days after the transcript of the hearing is filed, whichever is later. Plaintiff may file a supplemental brief in response.

This Court retains jurisdiction in the cause, and the time for proceeding with the appeal in this Court begins upon issuance of an order in the trial court that finally disposes of the remand proceedings.

If defendant fails to file remand pleadings in the trial court within the 14-day period, the time for proceeding with the appeal in this Court begins 14 days from the date of certification of this order.
