

The motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The motion to amend order of remand to include new issue is also GRANTED. The scope of the remand pursuant to our November 13, 2018 order, including the evidentiary hearing to be held on remand, is expanded to include the issue regarding alleged extraneous influences on the jury raised in the motion to amend order of remand. The time for the trial court to complete the proceedings on remand is extended until 56 days after the date of this order.

The motion to add new issue on appeal, which seeks filing of a supplemental brief at this point, is DENIED because the issue of possible improper extraneous influence on the jury would more appropriately be addressed in a supplemental brief after completion of the remand proceedings as allowed by this Court's November 13, 2018 order. Such a supplemental brief after remand could be prepared with the benefit of expansion of the record pursuant to the remand order and any determinations made by the trial court on remand.
