The motion to remand filed on July 19, 2018, is treated as a motion to expand the scope of the remand already ordered by this Court and is GRANTED as provided by this order. The trial court shall consider the shackling issue, including the claim of ineffective assistance of counsel, as part of the ongoing remand proceedings. In this regard, defendant shall file an appropriate motion in the trial court within 14 days after the date of this order as to the shackling issue. The time for the trial court to hear and decide the matters on remand is extended until 56 days after the date of this order.

The motion to file supplemental brief is DENIED as premature because, pursuant to our May 22, 2018 order, defendant may file a supplemental brief following completion of the remand proceedings and such a supplemental brief may address the shackling issue with the benefit of the record of the proceedings on remand and the trial court's determinations on remand as to that issue.

The motion to strike the supplemental brief submitted on July 19, 2018 is GRANTED.
