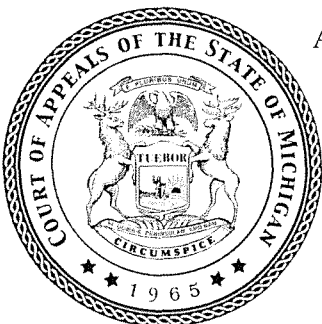

Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the December 7, 2017 judgment of divorce is not a final judgment appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). The judgment of divorce is not a final judgment under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) because it does not dispose of the issue of parenting time. Appellant may seek to appeal the December 7, 2017 judgment of divorce by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G). Alternatively, appellant may timely file a claim of appeal after a final judgment or order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) is entered in this case.
