In lieu of granting leave to appeal, pursuant to MCR 7.205(E)(2), the Court orders that defendant's sentences for carry a concealed weapon and possession with intent to deliver marijuana are VACATED and the matter REMANDED to the Genesee Circuit Court for resentencing on those charges only. At resentencing the circuit court is directed to state its reasons justifying the sentences imposed, including "an explanation of why the sentence imposed is more proportionate to the offense and the offender than a different sentence would have been." People v Dixon-Bey, 321 Mich App 490, 525; ___ NW2d (2017).
