Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the order dated December 28, 2017, and entered in the circuit court register of actions on January 3, 2018, is not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). That order is not a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) because it does not dispose of all claims in this case where it merely determines noneconomic damages are not available for the breach of contract claim but otherwise leaves that claim pending ultimate resolution. At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the January 3, 2018 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G).
