The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The motion for corrections to court records, removal of false information, and time to obtain transcripts and the motion to supplement that earlier motion are GRANTED TO THE EXTENT that appellant's brief on appeal for these consolidated appeals may be timely filed by September 14, 2018, i.e., 28 days after the filing of the two additional transcripts with the trial court on August 17, 2018. In all other aspects, the motions are DENIED. We note that, to seek to correct alleged errors in the lower court register of actions, appellant should contact the lower court clerk's office or, if he deems it appropriate, file a motion to correct the register of actions in the lower court. We further note that certain matters raised by appellant seem to involve claims of error in the lower court that, to the extent they may have merit, would properly be raised in appellant's brief on the merits of these appeals, but are not properly framed as seeking technical corrections to the lower court record.

Meter, J., would grant the motion for immediate consideration, but deny the remaining motions.
