The motions for reconsideration in Docket Numbers 342337 and 342354 are GRANTED, and the February 14, 2018 orders in these files are VACATED. Accordingly, the claims of appeal in these files are REINSTATED. In light of the Michigan Supreme Court's peremptory order in *Madson v Jaso*, ___ Mich ___; ___ NW2d ___ (Supreme Court Docket No. 154529, decided March 21, 2018), it is not clear that this Court lacks jurisdiction over these appeals. This order is without prejudice to further consideration of the jurisdictional issues by the case call panel or to the filing by appellee of a motion to dismiss on jurisdictional grounds if she concludes that is warranted based on further developments in Michigan case law. The time for filing appellant's brief(s) in these appeals under MCR 7.212(A)(1)(a)(i) shall be calculated as if the claims of appeal had been filed on the date of this order.

The motion for reconsideration in Docket Number 342352 is DENIED because the January 9, 2018 order denying appellant's motion for disqualification of the trial judge is clearly not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A).

The motions to expedite in Docket Numbers 342337 and 342354 are GRANTED TO THE EXTENT that the appeals are designated for treatment as expedited custody cases. The motions to waive fees in Docket Numbers 342337 and 342354 are GRANTED TO THE EXTENT that fees are waived for the filing of the claims of appeal and any motions that appellant files in this Court in the appeals. But the motions to waive fees are DENIED TO THE EXTENT that appellant requests this Court order waiver or suspension of fees for production of transcripts because he has not established a legal entitlement to production of transcripts at public expense.

The appeals in Docket Numbers 342337 and 342354 are CONSOLIDATED to advance the efficient administration of the appellate process.
