**In re Forfeiture of 2002 Dodge**

Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. The March 15, 2018 order from which the claim of appeal was filed is not a final order appealable by right. MCR 7.203(A)(1); MCR 7.202(6)(a). Specifically, MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) defines a final order to include “the first judgment or order that disposes of *all the claims* and adjudicates the rights and liabilities *of all the parties*.” (Emphasis added.) The March 15, 2018 order, which denied appellant’s motion for return of property, did not dispose of all the claims in the case; specifically, it did not dispose of the complaint for forfeiture of property. At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the March 15, 2018 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G).
