Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:


The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. The May 4, 2018 order from which the claim of appeal was filed is not a final order appealable by right. MCR 7.203(A)(1); MCR 7.202(6)(a). Specifically, MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) defines a final order to include “the *first* judgment or order that disposes of all the claims and adjudicates the rights and liabilities of all the parties.” (Emphasis added.) The May 4, 2018 postjudgment order is not the *first* judgment or order disposing of all the claims and adjudicating the rights and liabilities of all the parties in this case. At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the May 4, 2018 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G).
