Jane M. Beckering, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the April 26, 2018 order denying a motion for reconsideration is not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). Further, the claim of appeal cannot be saved by being treated as taken from the underlying December 4, 2017 order granting summary disposition to appellee. Particularly, the claim of appeal cannot be considered timely from the December 4, 2017 order under MCR 7.204(A)(1)(b) because the motion for reconsideration was not filed in the trial court within 21 days after entry of the December 4, 2017 order (even as extended to December 26, 2017 due to the Christmas Day holiday, MCR 1.108(1)) or further time allowed by the trial court during that period. At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the December 4, 2017 order and/or the April 26, 2018 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G).
