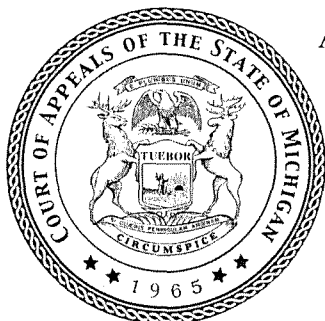

Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion to extend time to file appellant's brief is GRANTED until August 17, 2018.

The Court observes that in each of the appeals in which counsel represented the appellant in an appeal involving the termination of parental rights, she has requested extensions for filing the appellant's brief. See Docket Nos. 333724, 339180, and 341381. Cases involving termination of parental rights require expedited processing in the initial filing, the production of the transcript, the filing of the brief, and the placement on the case call. See MCR 7.204(A)(1)(c); MCR 7.210(B)(3)(b)(iii); MCR 7.212(A)(1)(a)(i); MCR 7.213(C)(2). Further, IOP 7.212(A)(1)-3 indicates that motions for extensions of time in cases where the appellant's brief is due in less than 56 days will be granted only for good cause shown, which is generally limited to unexpected events that directly impact the ability to timely file the brief. Counsel is advised that future extension in appeals involving termination of parental rights are discouraged and are unlikely to be granted absent a showing of such an unexpected event.
