
Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

On the Court's own motion, the delayed application for leave to appeal is DISMISSED because appellant, a prisoner under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections, filed the subject delayed application for leave to appeal even though he owes an outstanding balance to this Court in *Anthony Lynch-Bey v Dept of Corrections*, Docket Number 257290. A prisoner who is under the Department's jurisdiction cannot file another civil appeal or original action until the prisoner pays the outstanding balance owed in an earlier civil appeal or original action filed while under the Department's jurisdiction. MCL 600.2963(8).

The motions to waive fees and to remand are also DISMISSED as moot.
