Intervenor-defendant/cross-plaintiff Michigan One Fair Wage having filed a cross-complaint, the scheduling order issued by this Court on July 24, 2018 is VACATED. The allegations in the cross-complaint indicate that the July 27, 2018 action of the Board of State Canvassers may render moot the original mandamus complaint filed by Michigan Opportunity. Accordingly, the Court holds further pleading and briefing on the original mandamus complaint in abeyance pending resolution of the cross-complaint.

All parties shall adhere to the following revised schedule for filing documents and pleadings:

- On or before August 6, 2018, Michigan One Fair Wage shall file a brief presenting its arguments in support of its cross-complaint.
- On or before August 9, 2018, the Board of State Canvassers, the Secretary of State, and the Director of Elections shall file their answers to the cross-complaint, and a brief presenting their arguments regarding the cross-complaint.
- Michigan Opportunity may file an answer to the cross-complaint and an accompanying brief, pursuant to MCR 7.206(D)(2). Any answer by Michigan Opportunity to the cross-complaint, and any accompanying brief, shall be filed on or before <u>August 9, 2018</u>.
- Any party may file a reply brief, in which the party presents all responsive arguments regarding the cross-complaint. Any such reply brief shall be filed on or before <u>August 13</u>, 2018.
