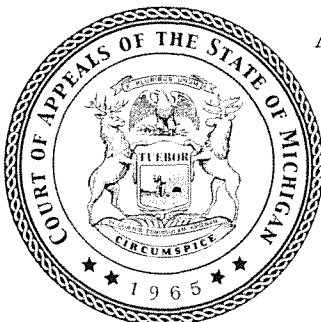

Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The motion to waive the filing fees is GRANTED and the fees are WAIVED for this case only.


The motion to remand and the delayed application for leave to appeal from the January 31, 2018 order denying defendant's successive motion for relief from judgment are DISMISSED because appellant failed to file the application within the time period required by MCR 7.205(G)(3). Furthermore, the exceptions found in MCR 7.205(G)(4) are inapplicable. Nevertheless, even if appellant's delayed application for leave to appeal had been timely filed, the application and accompanying motion to remand would have been dismissed because appellant has failed to demonstrate the entitlement to an application of any of the exceptions to the general rule that a movant may not appeal the denial of a successive motion for relief from judgment.
