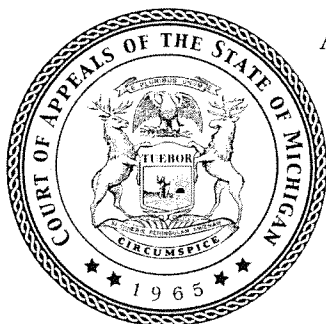
People of MI v Russell Roberson

Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The application for a delayed appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. Pursuant to MCR 7.205(G)(3), an application seeking a delayed appeal must generally be filed within six months of entry of the order appealed. Defendant's application was not filed within this six-month period. While defendant relies on MCR 7.205(G)(4)(a), (b), and (c) as a basis to avoid this limitation, the trial court's order appointing counsel indicates that the request for the appointment of counsel was not made within six months of entry of the judgment of sentence. Accordingly, the exception provided by MCR 7.205(G)(4)(a), (b), and (c) does not apply. At this point, defendant may "seek relief pursuant to the procedures set forth in subchapter 6.500." MCR 6.429(B)(4).
