Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:


The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. The August 16, 2018 order from which the claim of appeal was filed is not a final order appealable by right. MCR 7.203(A)(1); MCR 7.202(6)(a). Specifically, MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) defines a final order to include “the first judgment or order that disposes of *all the claims* and adjudicates the rights and liabilities of *all the parties*.” (Emphasis added.) The August 16, 2018 order did not dispose of all of appellant’s claims against defendant Jackson Area Transportation Authority. At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the August 16, 2018 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G).
