The Court orders that the motions for immediate consideration are GRANTED. The motion to permit appellants to file a reply to the responses to the motion for stay and motion to waive the transcript production requirement is GRANTED.

The motion to waive the transcript production requirement is GRANTED in part and DENIED in part. To the extent appellant seeks to waive the transcript and order production requirements of MCR 7.209(A)(3), for purposes of the motion to stay, the motion is GRANTED. To the extent appellant otherwise seeks to waive the production of transcripts for purposes of consideration of this application for leave to appeal, the motion is DENIED. Within 7 days after the Clerk's certification of this order, appellant shall order preparation of the best interest hearing transcripts and any other relevant transcripts on an expedited basis, and file with this Court copies of any prepared transcripts and the court reporter's certificates showing that the transcripts have been ordered. MCR 7.205(B)(4).

The motion for stay of transfer of the minor child and for stay of further action by the trial court is GRANTED, and further proceedings are STAYED pending further order of this Court. The minor child shall remain in the care and custody of appellants until further order of this Court. Appellee shall continue to have parenting time as was in place prior to the issuance of the trial court's October 5, 2018 opinion and order that is at issue in this appeal.

The Court orders that the application for leave to appeal is hereby HELD IN ABEYANCE until further order of this Court. Any other party to the case may file an answer or supplemental answer to the application within 21 days of the date of the Clerk's certification of this order. Appellants may file a reply within 14 days of service of any such answers.
