On its own motion, the Court directs each party to file a supplemental brief not later than 35 days after the date of this order specifically addressing the following questions: (1) whether the trial court abused its discretion by not permitting defendant to call a rebuttal expert to testify regarding domestic abuse victims' responses to domestic violence and fear of imminent threat of violence, (2) whether the trial court erred by not placing on the record its evidentiary decisions respecting the admissibility of the body cam footage where the record suggests that defense counsel raised objections off the record which the trial court denied and where the prosecution agreed to redaction of the video in some unspecified manner, and (3) whether aggravated domestic violence, MCL 750.81a(2), constitutes a necessarily included lesser offense of mayhem, MCL 750.397, and if the trial court erred by allowing the jury to consider convicting defendant of aggravated domestic violence despite not being charged with violation of MCL 750.81a(2).
