The Court orders that the second motion to remand is GRANTED. These cases are REMANDED to the trial court to allow defendants to bring an appropriate motion requesting the trial court to resolve these cases in accordance with the parties' agreement. Proceedings on remand are limited to the issues raised in the motion to remand. This Court retains jurisdiction.

Defendants shall initiate the proceedings on remand by filing an appropriate motion with the trial court within 14 days after the date of this order. Defendants shall file a copy of that motion with this Court. The trial court shall hear and decide the matter within 56 days of the date of this order.

If the trial court enters amended judgments of sentence in these cases in accordance with the parties' agreement the parties shall file a stipulation to dismiss these appeals within 14 days after entry of the amended judgments of sentence. If the trial court declines to resolve these cases in accordance with the parties' agreement, the parties shall file a copy of the trial court's order to that effect with this Court within 14 days after entry and that will conclude the remand subject to the ability of the parties to file a motion to file a supplemental brief as to the remand proceedings.
