On the Court's own motion, each party is directed to file a supplemental brief specifically addressing the following issues: Did the prosecution engage in misconduct by knowingly issuing an information that contained a charge that had been dismissed or had not been pursued at the preliminary examination? Even assuming that defendant was unfairly surprised by the inclusion of the charge in the information, can defendant establish prejudice requiring reversal of his conviction for manufacturing methamphetamine, MCL 333.7401(2)(b)(i)?

The supplemental brief of appellee is to be filed within 7 days of the date of this order, and the supplemental brief of appellant within 7 days after service of appellee's supplemental brief.
