On the Court's own motion pursuant to MCR 7.216(A)(7), the Court orders these cases are CONSOLIDATED to advance the efficient administration of the appellate process.

In docket no. 343669, pursuant to our Supreme Court's direction on remand, we remanded to the trial court for reconsideration of its November 14, 2017 opinion and order, and its April 12, 2018 order terminating respondent's parental rights. The trial court held hearings, issued a written opinion addressing the issues on remand, and entered an order that again terminated respondent's parental rights. In docket no. 350113, respondent appeals by right from that second termination order entered June 14, 2019.

Given that the appeal in docket no. 350113 arises out of the limited remand proceedings, in lieu of the parties filing any supplemental briefs after remand in docket number 343669, the Court orders that respondent-appellant shall file appellant's brief in docket no. 350113 within 21 days of the filing of the transcript of the May 13 and 21, 2019 hearings on remand. Appellee's brief is due within 14 days of service of appellant's brief. The parties' briefs may not exceed 20 pages, but shall comply with MCR 7.212(B)-(D) in all other respects. The clerk is directed to submit the consolidated appeals to this panel for decision without oral argument after the time for filing appellee's brief has run. MCR 7.214(E).
