The Court orders that the motion to remand is GRANTED. This case is REMANDED to the trial court to allow expansion of the record as to the relevant items discovered by plaintiff and for either party to file any motion considered appropriate on remand. This Court retains jurisdiction.

The parties shall initiate the proceedings on remand within 14 days of the date of this order. Each party shall file with this Court a copy of any pleading the party files in the trial court within 14 days after filing in the trial court, and defendant shall file a copy of any order entered within 14 days after entry. We direct the trial court to expressly state that the remand proceedings are concluded in the order that it enters that it determines will be the order concluding the remand proceedings.

The trial court shall hear and decide the matter within 56 days of the date of this order and shall make an appropriate determination on the record. The trial court shall order a transcript of any hearing on remand to be prepared at public expense and filed within 21 days after completion of the proceedings.

Defendant may file a supplemental brief addressing the issues raised on remand within 21 days after the date of entry of the trial court's order concluding the remand proceedings or the date the transcript is filed, whichever is later. Plaintiff may file a supplemental brief in response.
