On the Court's own motion, the parties shall appear for oral argument to answer questions about the factual basis for the assault with intent to do great bodily harm charge. Specifically, the parties should be prepared to explain: (1) whether the assault with intent to do great bodily harm charge and the assault with intent to murder charge addressed two different assaults and, if so, how the jury was informed that the two charges concerned separate assaults; and (2) if the jury was told that the two assaults should be considered as one assault for purposes of the assault with intent to murder charge, then what relief, if any, is defendant entitled to.
