Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), MCR 7.217, and MCR 7.219(I), orders:

The appellant's "brief" that was filed on September 5, 2019, is STRICKEN and the appeal is DISMISSED for want of prosecution. The "brief" as filed on September 5, 2019, with its numerous blank pages, does not remotely conform to the requirements of MCR 7.212(C). The Court's order of August 21, 2019, warned that the appeal would be dismissed for want of prosecution if the brief, which was initially due on March 7, 2019, was not filed by September 5, 2019, and appellant's counsel has failed to cure the defects in the brief in response to the Clerk's notice of the defects mailed on September 10, 2019.

David William Lewarchik (P78200), retained counsel for appellant, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court, within 21 days of the certification of this order, court costs in the sum of \$250 for allowing this appeal to appear on the involuntary dismissal docket. Such costs are personal to the attorney and shall not be charged back to the defendant.

The Clerk's Office is directed to mail a copy of this order to defendant, who is advised that MCR 7.217(D) provides a 21-day period in which to move for reinstatement of this appeal on a showing of mistake, inadvertence, or excusable neglect. Such a motion must be filed with this Court within 21 days of the Clerk's certification of this order.
