Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1) and MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

In light of the United States Postal Service's return as undelivered the mailing of the Court's order of March 6, 2019, to appellant, the March 6, 2019, order of dismissal is hereby reissued to change the date of entry of the order. The Clerk is directed to e-mail a copy of the order to appellant at the e-mail address that he used for e-filing the claim of appeal. In all other respects, the March 6, 2019, order remains unchanged as follows:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because it was not filed within 21 days of the order being appealed from, no motion for postjudgment relief was filed within the initial 21-day period, MCR 7.204(A)(1)(a), and the requirements of MCR 7.204(A)(3) have not been met. Dismissal is without prejudice to the filing of a late appeal under MCR 7.205(G), provided such a filing meets all requirements under the court rules and is not time-barred.
