Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the undated letter from the Director of Court Operations for the Marquette County Courts regarding the return of documents is not a judgment or order of the Marquette Circuit Court that may be appealed as of right. MCR 7.203(A). Further, a judgment or order of the district court is not directly appealable to this Court. MCR 7.203(A). Notably, if appellants wish to assert a claim in this Court that the Marquette Circuit Court improperly failed to file papers that they submitted for filing they may file an original complaint for superintending control in this Court against that circuit court. See MCR 7.206. This order expresses no opinion as to the merits of any such claim.

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED for this case only.
