Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. Regardless of the date of service on appellant of the September 18, 2018 order denying her motion for reconsideration of the August 9, 2018 order appealed from the claim of appeal was not timely filed because the time for filing the claim of appeal was not extended by the filing of the motion for reconsideration. This is because the motion for reconsideration, being filed on September 5, 2018, was not filed within 21 days after entry of the August 9, 2018 order and there is no indication that the trial court extended the time for filing the motion for reconsideration. MCR 7.204(A)(1)(b). Dismissal is without prejudice to the filing of a delayed application for leave to appeal the September 18, 2018 order denying the motion for reconsideration.
