People of MI v Scott John Oostdyk

Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. The claim of appeal from the December 1, 1983 judgment of sentence is untimely. MCR 7.204(A)(2). Further, to the extent appellant is trying to appeal the January 20, 2015 order denying a motion for relief from judgment under MCR 6.500 *et seq.*, that order is not appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(b); MCR 7.203(A)(1). An appeal from an order denying a motion for relief from judgment under MCR 6.500 *et seq.* must come by application for leave to appeal filed pursuant to MCR 7.205. MCR 6.509(A). Appellant, however, is precluded from filing a late appeal pursuant to MCR 7.205(G) from either the December 1, 1983 judgment of sentence or the January 20, 2015 order because the time for filing an application pursuant to MCR 7.205(G) has expired.
