Gladwin Circuit Court v County of Gladwin

Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is **DISMISSED** for lack of jurisdiction because the order dated February 19, 2019, and entered in the circuit court register of actions on February 25, 2019, is not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). That order is not a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) because, at minimum, it is evident from review of the circuit court register of actions that the claim(s) in intervenor UAW's complaint to enforce grievance settlement have not been disposed. Dismissal is without prejudice to the filing of a an application or delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205, provided such a filing meets all requirements under the court rules and is not time-barred. Alternatively, appellants may file a timely claim of appeal after entry of a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i).
