Pursuant to MCR 7.205(E)(2), in lieu of granting the application for delayed appeal, the Court VACATES the best-interest determination of the Family Division of the Branch Circuit Court and REMANDS this matter for the court to consider how the child's relative placement affects her best interests. In re Olive/Metts Minors, 297 Mich App 35, 43; 823 NW2d 144 (2012). The proceedings on remand are limited to this issue. We retain jurisdiction.

Proceedings on remand in this matter shall commence within 14 days of the Clerk's certification of this order, and they shall be given priority on remand until they are concluded. The parties shall promptly file with this Court a copy of all papers filed on remand. Within seven days after entry, appellant shall file with this Court copies of all orders entered on remand. The transcript of all proceedings on remand shall be prepared and filed within 21 days after completion of the proceedings.

Either party may file a supplemental brief pertaining to the issues raised on remand within 14 days after entry of the family court's order deciding the matter or 14 days after the transcript of the hearing is filed. The responsive party may file a brief in reply.
