Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. “The time limit for an appeal of right is jurisdictional.” MCR 7.204(A). The March 7, 2019 claim of appeal was not timely filed pursuant to any of the time provisions set forth in MCR 7.204(A), including that specified in MCR 7.204(A)(3). Assuming, without making a determination, that the September 4, 2018 judgment was served on February 14, 2019, the claim of appeal was not filed within 14 days of the delayed service of the judgment as required by MCR 7.204(A)(3). Dismissal is without prejudice to the filing of a late appeal under MCR 7.205(G), provided such a filing meets all requirements under the court rules and is not time-barred.
