The Court orders that the motion to waive fees is GRANTED for this case only.

The motion to extend time to file a brief in support of the application is GRANTED and the brief received on June 13, 2019 is accepted for filing.

The delayed application for leave to appeal is DISMISSED. Because defendant previously appealed and filed a post-judgment motion for relief, he could seek relief in the circuit court only under the procedures provided by Subchapter 6.500 of the Michigan Court Rules. MCR 6.429(B)(4). Defendant has failed to demonstrate the entitlement to an application of any of the exceptions to the general rule that a movant may not appeal the denial of a successive motion for relief from judgment. MCR 6.502(G). Moreover, even considering the merits of defendant's issues, they are without merit.

The motion to appoint counsel is DENIED.
