Pursuant to MCR 7.205(E)(2), the Court orders that in lieu of granting the application for leave to appeal, this matter is REMANDED for additional proceedings consistent with *People v Steanhouse*, \_\_\_ Mich App \_\_\_; \_\_ NW2d \_\_\_ (2019)(Docket No. 318329). The trial court is directed to articulate on the record why the sentence imposed is more proportionate to the offense and the offender than a different sentence would have been in accordance with the principle of proportionality outlined in *People v Milbourn*, 435 Mich 630; 461 NW2d 1 (1990). Proceedings on remand in this matter shall be conducted within 28 days of the Clerk's certification of this order, and they shall be given priority on remand until they are concluded.
