Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the August 16, 2019, order appealed from is not a final order as defined in MCR 7.202(6). MCR 7.203(A)(1). The postjudgment order regarding child support cannot be considered an order which grants or denies a motion to change legal custody, physical custody or domicile under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(iii). Because the August 16, 2019, order does not conform to the provisions of MCR 7.202(6)(a)(iii), or any of the other provisions of MCR 7.202(6)(a), it cannot be considered a final order. Dismissal is without prejudice to the filing of a late appeal under MCR 7.205(G), provided such a filing meets all requirements under the court rules and is not time-barred.
