People of MI v Eddie Damond Bowens

Jane M. Beckering, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The application for leave to appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the Saginaw Circuit Court had not entered an order before the prosecutor filed her application on November 7, 2019; thus, the application is premature. MCR 7.203(B); MCR 7.205(A). Because the Court lacks jurisdiction to entertain and decide the application, the Court also lacks jurisdiction to decide the accompanying motions. The motions for immediate consideration, to stay and to waive the requirements of MCR 7.209 are DISMISSED. This order is not intended to prejudice the ability of the prosecutor to file an application from the November 6, 2019 order denying her motion to stay proceedings. The prosecutor may also secure an order from the trial court effectuating the court's evidentiary ruling sought to be challenged and file an application from that order.
