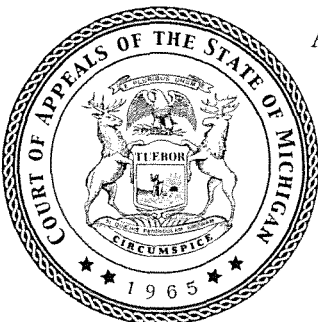

Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1) and MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED for this case only.


The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because it was not filed within 21 days of *entry of* the order being appealed from and no motion for postjudgment relief was filed within the initial 21-day appeal period. MCR 7.204(A)(1)(a). Entry of an order for purposes of MCR 7.204(A)(1) “means the date a judgment or order is signed, or the date that data entry of the judgment or order is accomplished in the issuing tribunal’s register of actions.” MCR 7.204(A). In this case, the order was signed on October 31, 2019 and was entered on the register of actions on October 31, 2019. Dismissal is without prejudice to the filing of a late appeal under MCR 7.205(G), provided such a filing meets all requirements under the court rules and is not time-barred.
