Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion to extend time to file appellee's brief is GRANTED until January 27, 2020.

The Court observes that child custody cases require expedited processing in the production of the transcript, the filing of the brief, and the placement on the case call. See MCR 7.210(B)(3)(b)(iii); MCR 7.212(A)(1)(a)(i); MCR 7.213(C)(2). Further, IOP 7.212(A)(2)-3 indicates that motions for extensions of time in cases where the appellee's brief is due in less than 35 days will be granted only for good cause shown, which is generally limited to unexpected events that directly impact the ability to timely file the brief. Counsel is advised that future extensions in appeals involving child custody are discouraged and are unlikely to be granted absent a showing of such an unexpected event.
